A Note from the Church & Ministry Development Commission

CAMP SONRISE MOUNTAIN EVENTS

Pastor Lee Kline presented us with an excellent book entitled, "Why Pray?" The foundation of all ministry in the local church must be prayer. "Jesus is the Vine and we are the branches...apart from Him we can do nothing. I think it is unfortunate that somewhere along the way the church left the corporate prayer meeting disappear. Lester Miller had shared with me when I was serving the Indian Head Church of God that when he was a young man he remembered how the believers would gather on Wednesday evening for prayer meeting and cry out loud for God to shine His light into the church and community and convict people of their need for salvation in Christ. I know that most of are congregations are praying in their homes but I personally believe that God is pleased when a congregation sets aside some time each week to come together for the purpose of seeking His face. I believe that if we want the Holy Spirit to fill our hearts, our congregations and dramatically impact our communities we must establish a corporate prayer meeting. Perhaps you could set aside a half hour before or after Wed. Bible Study for corporate prayer. Rev. F.O. Eakin tells how when he was a boy the churches of God held cottage prayer meetings on Sunday evening in different members homes. They would gather for prayer and share refreshments and fellowship after the prayer time. It was in these cottage prayer meetings that he learned to pray out loud with a group of Christians. This is something that many Christians are fearful of doing. Perhaps we need to start these up again. This excellent book, "Why Pray?," is available at the Allegheny Conference office for the cost of \$5.00 each. The book is divided into forty small chapters. But each chapter is filled with practical ways to use prayer to bring the kingdom of God to your church and community.
